Anderson, Richard R., Windsor, Ont.; University of Western Ontario, 1974; general surgery; FRCSC; former chief of surgery and hospital trauma team, Hotel-Dieu Grace Hospital; staff, Metropolitan General and Windsor Western hospitals. Died of kidney failure July 28, 2003, aged 53; survived by his wife, Judy, and 2 sons. "He was ambidextrous, which was a tremendous advantage in his field.
