
A VISUAL RESEARCH ABSTRACT

BACKGROUND

▶ There is no routine screening for latent tuberculosis (TB) infection in people migrating to Canada even though TB incidence may be high in some groups.

STUDY

Retrospective cohort study of people migrating to British Columbia, who became permanent residents of Canada between 1985 and 2012.



INTERPRETATION

Screening people at highest risk of TB upon arrival in Canada — and treating those who screen positive — could help move the country toward TB elimination.
